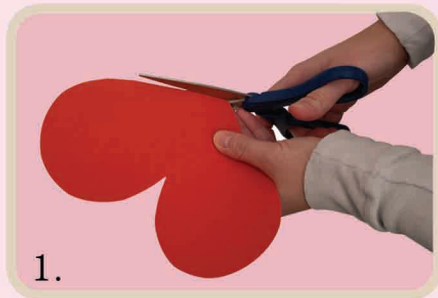


# Heart Wreath

What you'll need:

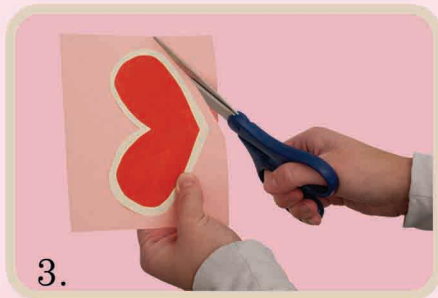
- construction paper (various shades of red, cream, white and pink)
- Scissors
- Glue
- Stapler
- String, yarn or ribbon
- Glitter (optional)



Take your choice of colored construction paper and cut out various sized hearts. Cut about 15-20 hearts per wreath.



Next, glue your hearts to another piece of colored construction paper.



Once dry, cut around the heart to create a background layer heart. Repeat the previous two steps as many times as you would like to create more layered hearts (we've created two layers).



Next, arrange your hearts into a circular wreath-like shape. Once you have your wreath in the shape you would like, glue or staple the hearts to one another to secure the wreath shape.



Lastly, once the wreath is dry, punch a hole at the top. Then, add string or ribbon to hang the wreath. Your heart wreath is now finished – enjoy!
