

Snowflake Wreath

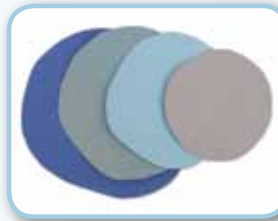
What you'll need:

- Construction paper – various shades of blue and grey
- 8.5" x 11" printer paper
- Scissors
- Glue
- String, yarn or ribbon



1. Cutting the Snowflakes

Cut a plain piece of white paper into a square. Then, fold the paper in half three times, the final time folding the paper into a triangle. You now have your snowflake shape and can be cutting out your design.



2. Construction Paper

Cut out different size circles to glue your snowflakes to. 10-15 snowflakes should be enough to create a medium-sized wreath.



3. Gluing Your Snowflakes

Glue each snowflake to a colored construction paper circle. Allow time to dry.



4. Creating Your Wreath

Next, arrange your snowflakes into a circular wreath-like shape.

Once you have your wreath in the shape you would like, glue or staple the construction paper circles to one another to secure the wreath shape.



5. Finishing Your Wreath

Lastly, once the wreath is dry, punch a hole at the top. Then, add string or ribbon to hang the wreath. Your wreath is now finished – enjoy!
